

Code of Conduct for School Visits

Your safety and welfare on College visits are of the utmost importance. This agreed code of conduct will help ensure our visit is successful.

You Must

- Follow the instructions of visit leaders and instructors.
- Dress and behave sensibly.
- Show courtesy and respect at all times, but particularly when dealing with members of the public.
- Inform a visit leader immediately of anything which might worry, hurt or threaten any student.
- Be punctual.
- Wear a seat belt, where provided, on transport and ensure that aisles are not obstructed.
- Follow all other safety instructions given on the visit.
- Carry emergency contact details at all times.
- Use your personal safety skills should you be approached by a stranger.
- Ensure that your personal property, including money, phone and other electrical equipment is safe.
- Use your mobile phone only if it is essential.
- Stay with your group when you are not directly supervised. You must not be on your own at any time.

Do Not

- Take unnecessary risks.
- Consume, purchase or otherwise acquire illegal substances including alcohol and cigarettes.

If there is any other significant poor behavior or infringement of school rules, the visit leader reserves the right to consider sending a student home, at the parents' expense.
