



## **Student Code of Conduct**

Your health, safety and welfare on College visits are of paramount importance.

This agreed code of conduct will help ensure our visit is successful.

### **YOU MUST**

- Not take unnecessary risks
- Follow the instructions of the group leaders and supervisors
- Dress and behave sensibly at all times
- Show courtesy at all times, but particularly when dealing with members of the public
- Look out for anything which might hurt or threaten anyone in the group and tell the group leader or supervisor about it as soon as possible
- Be punctual at all times
- Always wear a seat belt on the coach and ensure that bags do not obstruct aisles. You will be told about emergency doors, escape hammers, and first-aid kits on the coach – you must be aware of these at all times
- Use your personal safety skills should you be approached by anyone you do not know
- Stay together with your designated group when you are not directly supervised. Members of a group are responsible for each other at all times.

### **No Pupil should ever be on their own**

#### **Mobile Phones**

Students bringing a mobile phone should be aware that the loss or damage of such equipment is the responsibility of the student. The use of mobile phones should be restricted to times when students are unsupervised in sightseeing groups. On no account should a mobile phone be used to access the internet.

#### **Under no circumstances**

- Consume, purchase or otherwise acquire alcohol
- Smoke
- Bring through customs any alcohol, tobacco, flick-knives or fireworks (even as presents for others)
