# Year 7 Catch Up Funding

*Where students enter secondary schools below Level 4 in Reading and Maths at Key Stage 2, the Government provides some additional funding for the school to support those students with literacy and numeracy in Year 7.*

*For the academic year 2014 - 15, Chesterton received £16,000 to support initiatives to achieve accelerated progress for these students.*

*In reality this funding only partially covers the key areas in which the school invests which are:*

- *Initial testing to better assess baseline position and latent potential – Cost £500*
- *Small group teaching with a specialised curriculum - focussed on building core skills and rapidly consolidating those in order to open up the full curriculum. Additional teaching cost = £35K*
- *Specialist EAL provision where appropriate to accelerate English mastery – Additional teaching cost = £7K*
- *Provision and support for specific learning tools (eg Lexia reading scheme) – cost £3K*

*The progress of this students is very closely monitored with the aim of enabling rapid progress and therefore confident and effective access to a full curriculum as early as possible*
