Why? As a comprehensive progress check for the year that also helps prepare

students for the assessments they will face when they do their GCSEs

How to revise for the Year 8 Science Exam

Purchase a CGP KS3 Revision guide (available from the science technicians for £3). For each topic identify the keywords that you need to be familiar with and learn the definitions. Then review the key processes that come up in that unit (for example cell division or thermal decomposition). Practise either drawing diagrams to represent the process or writing short paragraphs using the keywords. Parents can help by using revision guides to test knowledge of facts that appear there.

To revise for the 'working scientifically' aspects, students should be able to describe how to carry out an experiment that will produce accurate and repeatable data. They should also be confident in explaining what the data shows. Again, information on this is in the revision guide.
